

## Attachment C - New and Revised OIC Dispute Resolution Forms

The modified forms are:

Name	Nature of Changes Since the Introduction of <i>Bill 59</i>
Application for Mediation	to include benefit entitlements according to the date of accident (under Bills 68, 164 or 59)
Application for Arbitration	to include benefit entitlements according to the date of accident (under Bills 68, 164 or 59) and to include reference to neutral evaluation and the option to access neutral evaluation through OIC Arbitration
Response to an Application for Arbitration	to allow insurers to include additional issues that were identified in mediation
Reply by the Applicant for Arbitration	to allow claimants to respond to new issues raised by the insurer
Notice of Appeal <sup>1</sup>	to limit appeals to questions of law
Response to Appeal <sup>1</sup>	to limit appeal responses to questions of law

New forms are:

Name	Purpose of Form
Agreement to Neutral Evaluation	confirmation of insurers' consent to OIC neutral evaluation
Joint Statement for Neutral Evaluation	confirmation that parties have agreed on issues to be evaluated; provision of potential dates for the evaluation meeting; and confirmation that all pertinent documents have been exchanged
