ORDER

No request requiring a hearing was delivered to the Financial Services Tribunal within the time prescribed by subsection 89(6) of the *PBA* respecting a Notice of Proposal to make an Order to wind up the **Lofthouse Brass Manufacturing Pension Plan for G. Bryant Brown** (the “Plan”).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Plan be wound up in full effective **May 27, 2008** for the following reasons:

There was a cessation or suspension of employer contributions to the pension fund.

The employer failed to make contributions to the pension fund as required by the *PBA*.

The employer is bankrupt within the meaning of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act (Canada).

All or a significant portion of the business carried on by the employer at a specific location was discontinued.
