## NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

**I PROPOSE TO MAKE AN ORDER** under section 69 of the *PBA* that the **Pension Plan for Certain Hourly-Rated Employees at the Toronto, Ontario Factory Service Branch of Trailmobile Parts & Service Canada Ltd.**, (the “Plan”), be wound up effective **March 13, 2009**.

### REASONS:

- 1. The employer is bankrupt within the meaning of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act (Canada).**
- 2. All or a significant portion of the business carried on by the employer at a specific location has been discontinued.**
- 3. Such further and other reasons as may come to my attention.**

**YOU ARE ENTITLED TO A HEARING** by the Financial Services Tribunal (the “Tribunal”) pursuant to section 89(6) of the *PBA*. **To request a hearing, you must deliver to the Tribunal a written notice that you require a hearing, within thirty (30) days after this Notice of Proposal is served on you.**<sup>1</sup>
