ORDER


ON OR ABOUT April 26, 2016, the Superintendent of Financial Services (the
“Superintendent”) issued a Notice of Intended Decision to Refuse to Make an Order
(the “*NOID*”) revoking the registration of Amendment Number 15 of the Canadian
Commercial Workers Industry Pension Plan, Registration Number 0580431 (the “*Plan*”) under
sections 18(1) and 89(1) of the *PBA*.

A REQUEST FOR HEARING was delivered to the Financial Services Tribunal on behalf
of the Applicant, JJ, within the time prescribed by section 89(6) of the *PBA*.

THE REQUEST FOR HEARING was later withdrawn on behalf of the Applicant on or
about August 29, 2016.

For the reasons set out in the NOID, I REFUSE TO MAKE AN ORDER revoking the registration of Amendment Number 15 of the Plan under sections 18(1) and 89(1) of the PBA.
