NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

I PROPOSE TO MAKE AN ORDER under section 78(4) of the *PBA*, consenting to the
payment out of the Plan to **Schenker of Canada Limited**, as at **April 01, 2008** in the amount of
\$14,812.00 plus interest to the date of payment.

REASONS:

1. **Schenker of Canada Limited** is the employer as defined in the Plan.
2. As a result of **an administrative error, pension expenses were paid by Schenker of Canada Limited which should have been paid out of the pension fund.**
3. Evidence of the overpayment to the fund has been submitted to the Financial Services Commission of Ontario.
4. Such further and other reasons as may come to my attention.

In accordance with section 105(1) of the *PBA*, an extension of the time limit under section 78(4) has been given.

YOU ARE ENTITLED TO A HEARING by the Financial Services Tribunal (the “Tribunal”) pursuant to section 89(6) of the *PBA*. **To request a hearing, you must deliver to the Tribunal a written notice that you require a hearing, within thirty (30) days after this Notice of Proposal is served on you.**¹
